## **NBCHS ASSESSMENT POLICY**

1. Please remember the Living Sky School Division #202 Assessment Policy for high school (i.e. Grade 10, 11, 12) students states the following: students who have not submitted ALL of the REQUIRED summative evidence of learning for each course will not attain credit for the course. NO grade will be reported to the Ministry of Education and the student will not be eligible to write a Departmental exam that semester.
2. Please remember the LSKYSD policy states the following: a “Final Submission Day” for required assignments will be clearly communicated to students for both semesters.
3. **THE SUBMISSION DATES FOR the 2015/16 school year are November 13, December 18 and January 8, April 22, May 20 and June 10 AT 3:30 P.M.** Students who have outstanding assignments after those dates may be removed from the credit. This could mean the student MUST repeat the credit the next semester or the next year. **This could mean that the student is NOT eligible to graduate in June 2016.**
4. NBCHS students have been advised about this new policy in writing and verbally since the first week of school in September. Teachers are providing many opportunities for students to complete work that has missed the deadline. The principal and vice-principals have counseled many students and provided opportunity and time in the Guided Study class to finish late assignments.
5. The noon hour “Math Help” room operates Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. Math teacher volunteers are in the designated classroom to provide any student in the school with support and tutoring.
6. Subject teachers are available by appointment to meet with students to provide support.
7. Counselling services are available to support students.
