All awards/scholarships/bursaries are based on an average calculated from English A and B 30, a Canadian Studies 30, a Math 30, a Science 30, and one (1) other best 30 level subject.

Please note that these scholarships have been awarded in previous years, but may change in the current year.

AWARDS

***GOVERNOR-GENERAL NOMINEE (Bronze Medallion)**

This award is given to the student who achieves the highest average upon graduation from high school. The average includes all grade 11 and 12 courses taken. This award is given at the graduation exercises and is a very prestigious award. Nominees are chosen by the Grad Awards Committee.

VALEDICTORIAN

This award is given to a student who has the highest number of student activity points (does not include academic points) in six (6) semesters and is on the Grade 12 Honour Roll. This is chosen by the Grad Awards Committee.
